- Recognize lymphovascular invasion pattern recognition.
- Understand the differential diagnosis of papillary lesions.
- Know the differential diagnosis of inflammatory lesions of the nipple.

#### *A Day in the Life of a Breast Surgeon*

- Define the surgical and pathologic differences in outcomes for patients treated with neoadjuvant chemo or endocrine therapy.
- Define the changing landscape of nodal evaluation in patients with early stage breast cancer.
